The EFI Foundation was established by Ernest J. Moniz, who served as the U.S. Secretary of Energy from 2013 to 2017. Moniz placed science-based analysis at the forefront of U.S. energy policy. The EFI Foundation, a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, proudly follows this ethos of independent analysis and public education on the energy transition. Moniz was a key architect of the 2015 Paris Agreement on climate change, the Iran Nuclear deal, and Mission Innovation, a global effort to increase investment in low-carbon energy technologies.
